Privacy and Security Statement

This statement sets out this Site's policies relating to the privacy and security of your "personal information" and security of your other information. This privacy and security statement applies only to this Site.

This Site collects and uses the following information from users:

1. A record of your visit and logs the following information for statistical purposes - the user's IP address, the date and time of the visit to the Site, the pages accessed and documents downloaded, the previous website visited and the type of browser used. No attempt will be made to identify individual users except, in the unlikely event of an investigation, where a law enforcement agency may exercise a warrant to inspect our service provider's logs. This information is analysed at the end of each month to determine the Site's usage statistics.
2. The Site retains the e-mail address of people who send E-mails through the "Contact Us" and "Leave a Reply" facility, for the purpose of sending a response. They are securely stored and will not be used for any other purpose, or disclosed without your consent.
3. Your personal information will not be disclosed to a third party.
